      - (2) Head Coaches Rules training the fine has increased to \$50 first time and \$100 for second.
      - (3) SafeSchools or individual school concussion training does not meet the UHSAA requirement for the yearly coach concussion training. Training must be completed on [www.nfhslearn.org](http://www.nfhslearn.org) - each year
